Dear Praying Friends and Family:

Please excuse our delay in sending this prayerletter update. As if moving isn't difficult enough, Christine's health worsened in late February. After enduring nearly two years of ongoing medical issues, she ultimately faced invasive abdominal surgery on June 22nd. I was more than busy as Christine was unable to do much of anything for the first few weeks. Please no inquiries, but be assured that she is finally doing well. In spite of her activity restrictions, she was doing well enough to receive doctor's permission to travel with me to the Rock of Ages National Conference in Cayce, SC at the end of July. Just as things seemed to be going better, we both ended up getting really sick enroute to South Carolina. We were feeling better after a week or so, but Christy got sick again on the way home. Lordwilling, she is finally over her illnesses and seems to be feeling well enough to travel with me to southern Idaho for a few church meetings in late August.

This 20th ministry anniversary year has probably been one of the most challenging we have faced, but even in the face of adversity, we know the Lord is still working. The military chaplain and I have been working together to prepare curriculum, classes, policies and procedures for the new facility in spite of continuing problems and delays with the new prison and with the officials. The chaplain and I are taking part in the Military Police training that is underway with more in-facility training to commence in October. Please continue to pray for my appointment orders from the facility commander. Through these times of difficulty, uncertainty, and frustration, we remain confident in HIM. The Lord is faithful and HE is our help!

Thank you to those who prayed for the revival services at the two Fort Leavenworth military prisons in late May. The Lord blessed with great attendance and six men made professions of faith in the Lord! We are grateful for the open door we have at America's largest military correctional facility.
