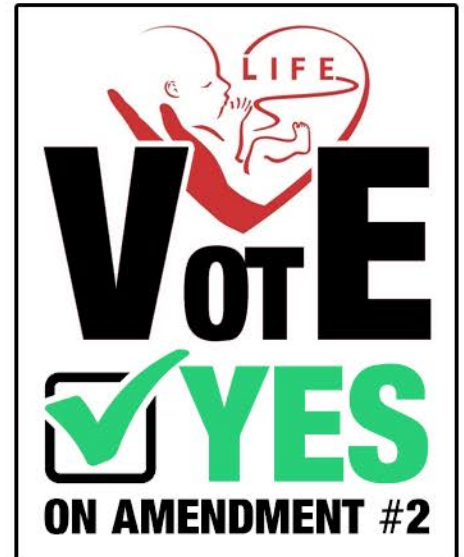

There is a HUGE item before Kentucky that I hope you’ll help with in the coming months. With Roe vs. Wade reversed, it’s up to each state to decide if abortion will be legal or not. Though Kentucky has a “trigger law,” which ends abortion in nearly all cases, a few liberal judges have been over-ruling the entire state legislature by saying that law is “unconstitutional.” November 8th there will be a measure on YOUR BALLOT to add an amendment to the Kentucky constitution. If the people vote to pass this, no judge can rule the pro-life law is unconstitutional because it will be IN the constitution. The people must vote to approve this amendment. It will be listed as proposal number 2. Here is the exact wording that will be on the ballot:



Are you in favor of amending the Constitution of Kentucky by creating a new Section of the Constitution to be numbered Section 26A to state as follows:

“To protect human life, nothing in this Constitution shall be construed to secure or protect a right to abortion or require the funding of abortion.”

The media is not covering this chance to end abortion forever in Kentucky. Many pro-life people don’t even know this is up for a vote. It’s up to us to spread the word and get people to vote “yes” Nov. 8th on Constitutional Amendment #2!
