Greetings and Happy Fall from Germany. It was an unusually warm summer, so the cooler temps, leaves changing, and sweater weather is a welcomed sight. August was a busy month for us as we had our VBS for the first time in 2 years. It was a blessing to have a missionary we support, Crystal Buegal, come and do a Lego themed VBS. We had a total of 15 children and a mother that came every night. On Saturday we had our ending program and big reveal of the Lego city, where parents got to see what their children learned and built. The Gospel was presented, we had a pizza lunch fellowship, and then afterwards many parents stayed to help with some cleanup. It was a lot of work to put up and tear down, but well worth the time and effort put in. We had help from almost every person in the church.

In September we had our mission conference. It was preached by our friend Pastor Gib Wood who has been a missionary here in Germany for over 30 years. He has been our mission speaker for the last couple of years and our people love him. We had our conference nightly Weds-Friday and then on Saturday we had a special BBQ fellowship and games with our people. Services were well attended; we even had a few missionary drop-ins and some video updates. On Sunday, we took up our faith promise commitments and had our international potluck. As a military church, we have a constant turnover of members. Even after losing two of our giving families this summer, we saw an increase in our Missions commitment and we are able to give our missionaries a monthly raise of \$15.00. So excited and humble to be a part of Gods work and watch the people grow.

We have many things coming up in the Fall. We are kicking off an adopt-a-missionary program that will give our people a chance to adopt one of our missionaries to connect with and encourage over this year. We are also starting a 5th Sunday game, dessert, and fellowship time. This church really has a special love for fellowship. Our family will have the opportunity to go to a missionary retreat at the end of October thanks to dear friends of ours who paid our way. We look forward to being around other missionaries and having a time of refreshing and encouragement. Finally, the 18th Airborne Corp which has been deployed here to support the Ukrainian mission will be leaving. We have had two men faithfully attending and participating in services during their deployment. We hate goodbyes but look forward to the new unit coming in and the new opportunities for Christ they represent.
